

aFe POWER recommends professional installation on this product. Thoroughly inspect the aFe POWER exhaust system to make sure there is no damage from shipping (if damage is noted, immediately contact a Fe POWER customer service). Allow time for your vehicle to cool down prior to installation. When working on your vehicle proceed with caution. Wear protective safety equipment; eye goggles and gloves to ensure a safe installation.

Install band clamps to proper torque specifications of 40-45 ft-lb.

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- 1. (Read instructions prior to installation.) It is recommended to not fully tighten the exhaust until it has been fully installed. Leave loose for adjustability.
- 2. Secure vehicle on jack stands (refer to your manual for specified jack stand positions).
- 3. For faster installation, spread out the parts of the exhaust alongside your vehicle as shown in the diagram above.
- 4. Secure the stock exhaust with jack/stands.
- 5. Loosen the (x2) nuts securing the muffler assembly to the OE mid-pipe.
- 6. Remove the (x3) isolation mounts on the muffler assembly using hanger pliers or a pry bar and remove the OE muffler assembly.
- 7. Loosen the (x2) nuts securing the mid-pipe to the downpipe.
- 8. Remove the (x1) isolation mount on the mid-pipe using hanger pliers or a pry bar and remove the OE mid-pipe.
- 9. Using the provided gasket and the OE (x2) nuts, install the Takeda Race-pipe Assembly.
- 10. Slide the hanger on the Takeda Race-pipe into the OE isolation mount.
- 11. Install the Takeda resonator using the supplied (x2) 3" band clamps.
- 12. Install the Takeda Mid-Pipe 1 using the provided 3" band clamp.
- 13. Install the Takeda Mid-Pipe 2 Assembly using the provided 3" band clamp.
- 14. Assemble the Takeda Muffler Assembly and Takeda Tailpipe outside of the vehicle using the supplied 3" band clamp, 3" V-Band, (x2) M8 nuts and (x2) M8 bolts. See reference image (2) for bracket orientation. Note: At this time, you can choose to install the 1-1/4" ST Sound-Core if you would like.
- 15. Install the Takeda Muffler and Tailpipe section to the Takeda Mid-pipe section using the supplied gasket, (x2) M10 bolts and (x2) M10 nuts.
- 16. Ensure that all the components of the Takeda exhaust system are aligned and are at a safe clearance from all wires, hoses, brake lines, body parts, and tires.
- 17. Start from the front of the Takeda exhaust system and evenly tighten all clamps and fasteners.
- 18. Start the vehicle and check for any leaks. If any leaks are found, determine cause and repair as necessary.
- 19. Remove vehicle from jacks stands.
- 20. It is recommended to re-tighten all clamps and hardware after 50-100 miles.
